Chairman Jolene Lambert began the meeting at 5:00 p.m.

Darian Musick, Crossroads Engineering spoke stating the benefits of increasing water rates in order to receive more funding. Virginia Department of Health (VDH) and Rural Development (RD) require a certain threshold of revenue before funding is awarded. This threshold has been met for funding that has been awarded but not completed yet. Rate increases could be set at a percent to reoccur annually instead of having increase large percentages every several years. This is something that can be visited with budgeting for the next fiscal year.

Another item discussed was increasing Woodway Water's current rate. Before this rate can be increased a rate increase of all customers would be required. This can be considered if all other rates are increased in the next fiscal year.
